HARLESS OR PETER CAVE CEMETERY WOODVILLE, WEST VIRGINIA

The Harless Cemetery is located on the hill near the lumber company in Woodville. Bill Bowman said the train station which was located there was called "Fork Junction". The cemetery is on the other side of State Road # 3 from Whitten's Grocery.

Fences divided family sections. Therefore, this record is given in sections rather than rows. There were more than thirty unmarked graves in the cemetery. One unmarked grave was that of the infant son of Feaster and Mary (Griffith) Vickers.

The cemetery was recorded by Angie (Pauley) Williams, Nellie (Williams) McClure and Ruth (Williams) Cornell on Jan. 25, 1981.

- Williams was born in Clay County; the daughter of Thomas Hamilton and Synthia Emoline (Hughes) Nutter. Georgia was married to John Alexander Williams in Clay County on 15 Aug. 1896. She died in the home of her son, Romie, at Julian, Boone County.
- J. A. WILLIAMS 11 Aug. 1874 25 Aug 1926 (John Alexander Williams was born in Nicholas County; the son of Samuel Fowler and Elizabeth Mary (Bailes) Williams. Samuel was a soldier in the Civil War. He is buried in the Wood Cemetery on Pisgah Mountain about five miles from the city of Clay. Mary is buried beside him but has no marker. John was fatally injured at the Warner Block Coal Company tipple at 2:14 P. M. Wednesday, Aug. 25. He was put on a hand car in order to be transported down Coal River to a hospital in Kanawha County. He died near McCorkle before reaching the hospital. His son-in-law, Whitman Romie "Peg" Hill, was with him. John was a minister in the Baptist Church.
