

~~Johnson Cemetery~~ is located in Lincoln County, WV, on Upper Mud River Road, approximately 3.5 miles from the junction of Upper Mud River Road and WV Rt. 3. This cemetery is located on what used to be the Elisha Johnson farm in the early part of the 1900's. To get to the cemetery, you have to cross over Mud River via a steel one-lane bridge located on the left side of the highway. Proceed to the top of the hill by way of the dirt road to the cemetery that is located on private land. There were numerous unmarked graves and some with broken tombstones. Some of the tombstones were not readable. If anyone knows of someone else besides who is on this list that was buried in this cemetery and that I missed somehow, please let me know. She had been suffering from tuberculosis for a number of years, and on about Jan. 1, she suffered an attack of the flu which was the direct cause of her death. She is survived by one brother, Harry Pennington, of West Point, Calif.; two sisters, Isabel Miller at Elizabeth, Vaeger, of Myra; seven children, Flora, Bailey, of Middletown, Hiram, Pennington, of Dehue, Hughie Rosco, Gladys, Mabel and Bessie May Pennington, at home. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. T. Black at the home, at burial was in the Johnson cemetery near Myra.

The Johnson cemetery is located on land that belonged to Franklin (Frank) Johnson. After his death, the property belonged to Elisha "Uncle Lish" Johnson. Elisha Johnson died 23 August 1956, and the property was sold. I dont know the name of the present owner.

The cemetery is located on Route 3, Mud River road, half way between West Hamlin and Myra, West Virginia. The area of the cemetery is about one-half acre.
